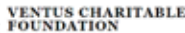

Connect To Greatness®, Inc (C2G) is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization that exposes African American/Black male students in elementary, middle, and high school in Palm Beach County to alternative programming and experiences to ignite their curiosity and creativity.

Dr. Cassandra Corbin-Thaddies, our founder and board director, is author of the 2022 dissertation, *Becoming High Academic Achievers: What are the Supporting Factors for African American/Black Male Students that Make the Difference*. The study shows that **connection, belonging, and trust** are critical foundational conditions for Black male students to thrive and achieve high academic success.



OUR PROGRAMS

BOYS TO MEN LEADERSHIP ACADEMY guides and supports African American/Black boys ages 11-18 to become responsible men and blaze their paths to greatness.

CONNECTING FUTURE LEADERS HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM builds on the foundation of connection, belonging, and trust to continue to shape future leaders.

WOMEN OF BOYS EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM supports caregivers to build their skills and confidence to advocate for their sons at school and learn how to influence policy in their communities, including being an informed voter.

LUNCHBOX TALKS sessions are offered on school campuses during lunchtime to a select group of students who school faculty identify as needing or could benefit from an African American/Black male mentor or coach.
